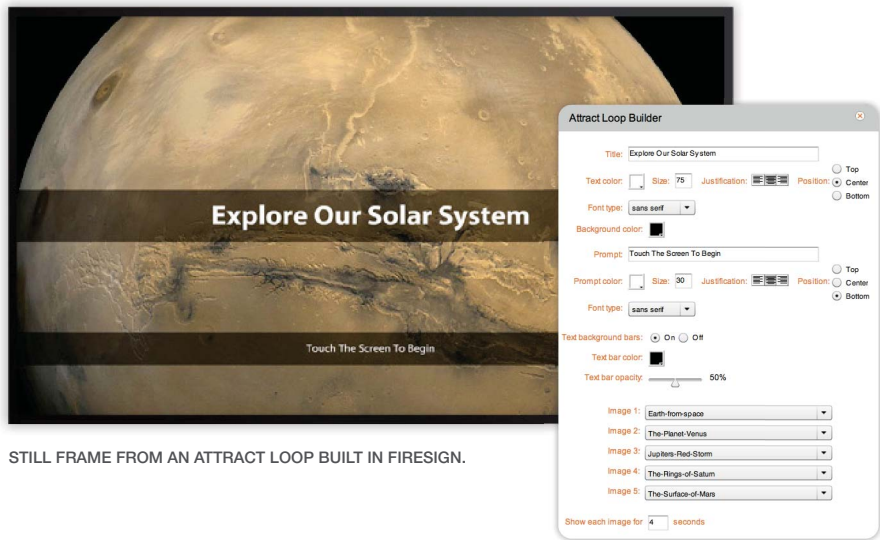
Attract Loop Builder

An attract loop is similar to a screensaver for your FireSign system. Attract Loops are useful for inviting visitors to interact with your content, and they also prolong the life of your screen by reducing burn-in.

In the application editor, access the Attract Loop Builder through the Global Settings panel. Enter and format your attract loop title and prompt text, then select up to five images from your media library. These images will dissolve in and out at the duration you specify.

HELPFUL TIPS:

- The Attract Loop Builder does not scale or resize your images. To create attract loops with full-screen images, you must select or create media items that match the exact resolution of your display screens.
- In the Media library, you must identify your attract loop image with the tag “attract.”



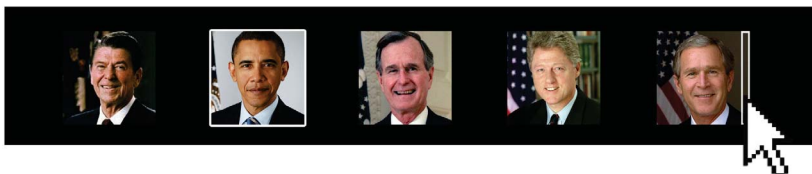
STILL FRAME FROM AN ATTRACT LOOP BUILT IN FIRESIGN.

Re-Ordering

The new re-ordering feature allows you to modify the order of your categories, text entries or image thumbnails. Select the entry that is out of place, and then click the item a second time to engage the re-order mode. Move your cursor to the desired location, and then click one last time to place the item in the proper location.



HELPFUL TIPS:

- The vertical placement bar appears to the left or right (or top and bottom) of the item under the cursor as you hover the mouse over different items in the list.
- Click outside the current list to cancel the re-order mode.

Accessible Navigation

This new feature gives visitors with limited reach access to all interactivity on your touchscreen by creating a secondary navigation option near the bottom of your screen. This feature may be activated through the Global Settings panel in each application editor.

When a visitor touches the handicap symbol, a strip of controls will slide out from the symbol, and a brief explanation of the feature will appear on the screen. The numbers in the strip correspond to a set of buttons or touch areas on the screen and interface. Touching a number in the strip is the same as touching the corresponding numbered item on the interface.

HELPFUL TIPS:

- To comply with ADA guidelines for touchscreen interactives, the accessible touchpoints should be 36 to 48 inches from the floor.

Location Information in FireSign Event Finder

In the previous version of FireSign Event Finder, event information would override the location description. The new version of this application adds an information button near the bottom of the screen. This button allows visitors to view the location description regardless of the number of events assigned.

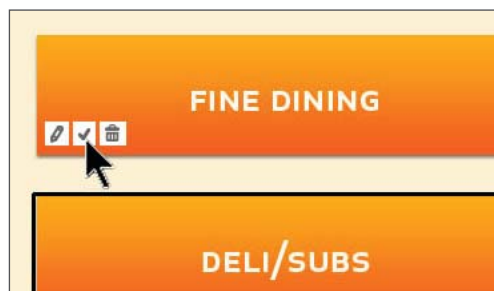


HELPFUL TIPS:

- Current users of the FireSign Event Finder Application may have created all-day/ every-day events as a work-around for displaying location information. These users will need to update the location information and then delete the "placeholder" events.

Layering in FireSign Interactive Guide

In the previous version of FireSign Interactive Guide, users may have experienced problems when attempting to select points of interest and touchpoints that were placed in close proximity. In the updated application, each click brings the point of interaction to the top layer. This feature makes it easier to access the edit, select and delete icons for each item.
